A CORE STRATEGY FOR INCREASING COLLEGE SUCCESS

Dual credit participation is linked to improved high school graduation rates and better college outcomes. By providing an opportunity to earn college credit at a **low cost**, dual credit is a core strategy for Latinx **success**.

A CORE STRATEGY FOR A HIGHLY-SKILLED WORKFORCE

Because **only 17%** of Latinx students are completing a postsecondary degree, the regional economy will experience a significant **talent shortage** in high demand fields.

We support efficient and aligned dual credit opportunities for students to increase educational attainment, improve professional pathways, and advance the quality of life for Latinx families.
